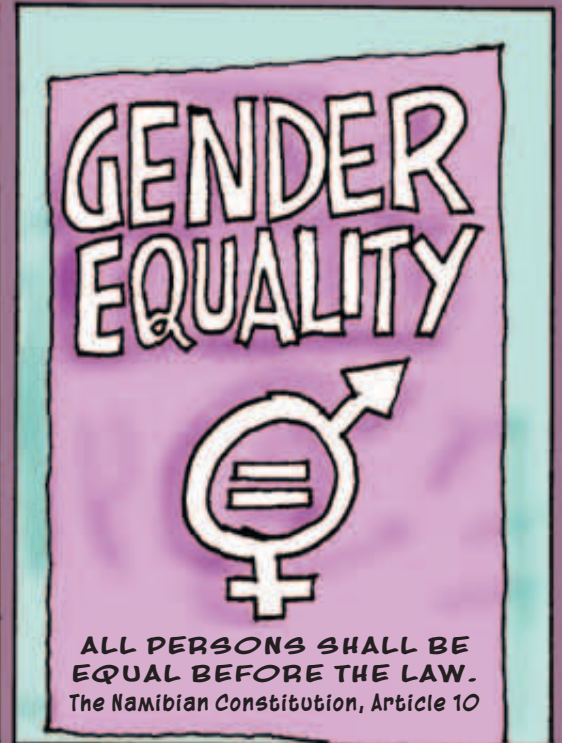
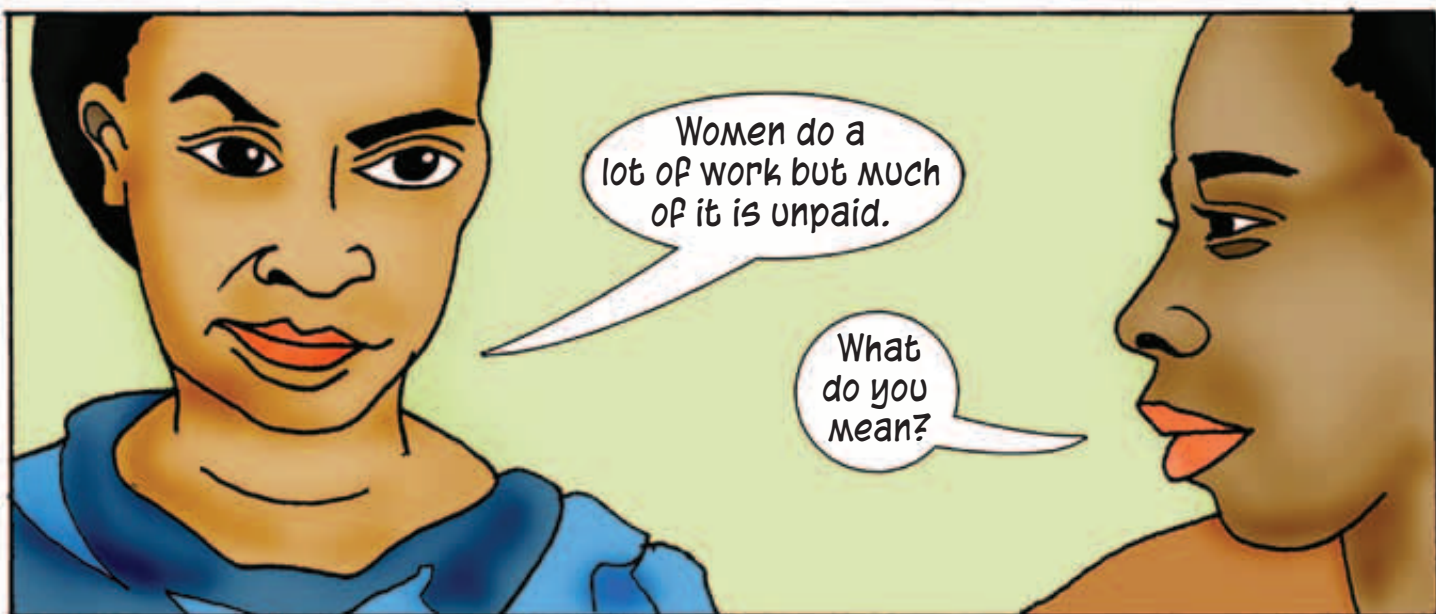


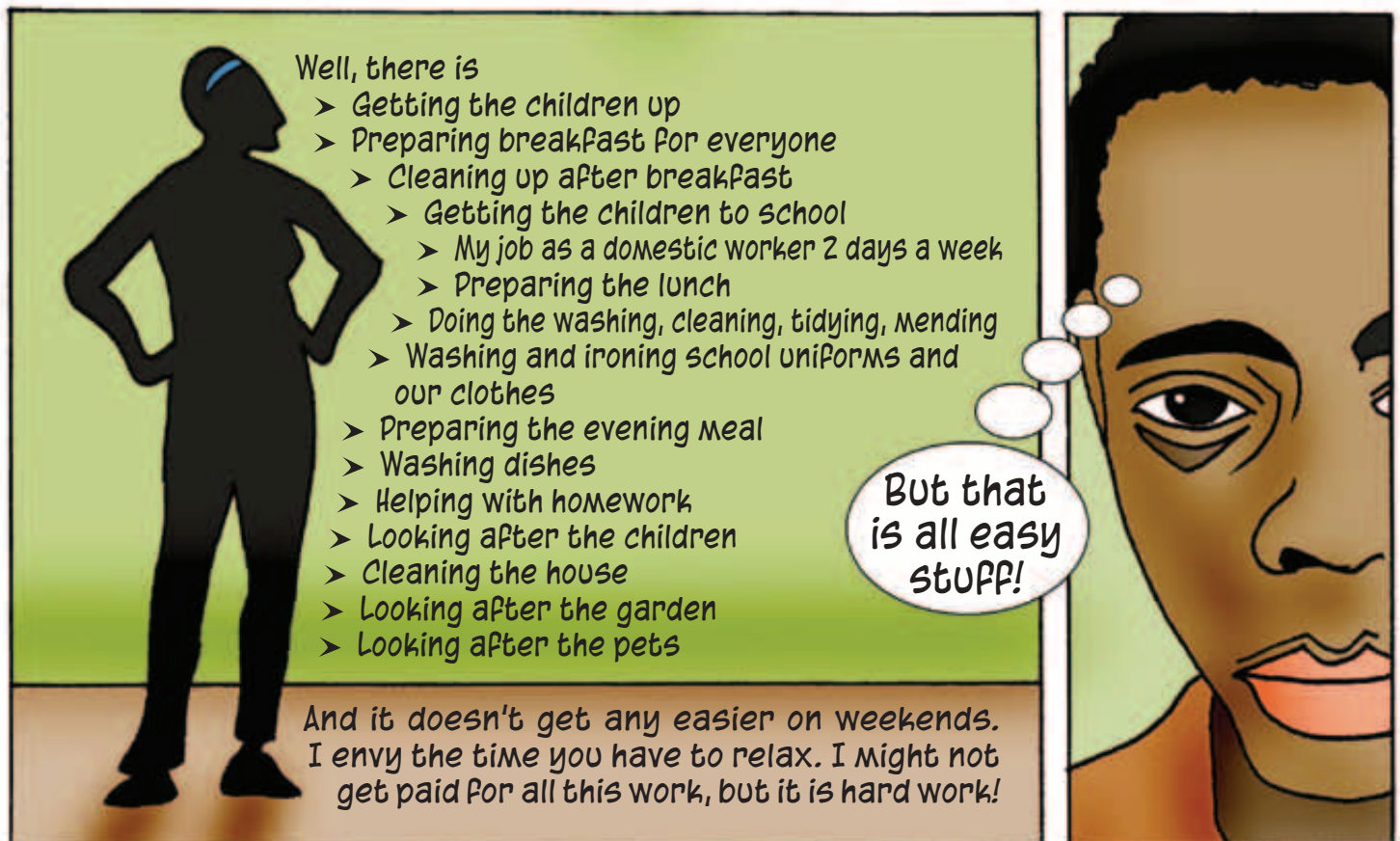

THE NEXT DAY ...




I have caught the flu. I can't even get out of bed. Can you look after the children today?

I think it is terrible. Men should be men. They should not have to cook and clean.


I think that it is a great example to young people. I have a full-time job. I can't do all the household tasks by myself. I hope that when I get married, my husband will help me.
