The ENOC working theme for 2013 addresses the situation and the respect of the rights of “children on the move”.

In this context and in parallel with other activities on the same issue, ENOC is organising on 30-31 May 2013 a Spring working seminar to prepare an ENOC position statement on the subject in advance of the Annual Autumn Conference.

The purpose of the Seminar is to serve as a forum for participating ENOC member institutions to exchange experiences and views on issues affecting the situation of “**children on the move**” in their respective countries. The Seminar will allow ENOC members to meet, discuss and agree a plan of action, drafting a statement to be agreed by the General Assembly in Brussels (September 2013).

For the preparation of the draft statement, ENOC and Seminar participants will be assisted by an external expert advisor, Mr. Yves Pascouau, expert on migration issues at the European Policy Centre.

The Seminar is kindly hosted by the Office of the Catalan Ombudsman with the special assistance of the staff of the Catalan Deputy Ombudsman for Children’s Rights.
